Tournament Type: WA-State Rated Invitational Chess Tournament

This chess tournament is open to all players in grades K-6. This tournament will consist of 5 rounds of games followed by an award ceremony.

Individuals of all levels are welcome. Come compete and cheer on your school! Team trophies will be awarded for the top 7 schools (top 4 scores from each school are counted towards the team scores). All kindergartners, First Time Tournament participants and 3+ point winners will receive an award. Players who receive 3 or more points will qualify for the WA State Elementary Chess Championship Tournament which happens on April 29, 2017 in Tacoma. (Registering for the State tournament is still required after qualifying.)

Participation in a chess club is not needed. It is possible to participate in a fewer number of games if you inform the tournament director prior to pairings.

Tournament Format: 5 round Swiss **Time Control:** G/25. **Sections:** K only, 1-3rd Grade and 4-6th Grade. NWSRS rated.
