#### **Washington State Rated Elementary Chess Tournament**

This chess tournament is for elementary students in grades K-5 and will consist of 5 rounds of games followed by an award ceremony.

**Individuals of all levels are welcome.** Come compete and cheer on your school! Team trophies will be awarded for the top 3 schools (top 4 scores from each school are counted towards the team scores). All kindergartners, first-time tournament participants and 3+ point winners will receive an award. Players who receive 3 or more points will also qualify for the WA State Elementary Chess Championship Tournament happening on April 21, 2018 (registering for the State tournament is still required after qualifying). Participation in a chess club is not required.

Format: 5 Round Swiss Time Control: G/30 Sections: K-1<sup>st</sup> Grade, 2<sup>nd</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup> Grade and 4-5<sup>th</sup> Grade

#### Schedule:

- Check-In (only for those that did not pre-pay): 9:00 a.m. (30 minutes prior to the first round)
- Pre-Paid Arrival Time (no check-in needed): 9:15 a.m. (15 minutes prior to the first round)
- Rounds: First round starts at 9:30 a.m., Round 2: 10:45 a.m., Lunch, Round 3: 12:30 p.m., Round 4: 1:45 p.m., Round 5: 3:00 p.m. (round times are approximate and may be pulled up earlier if possible)
- Award Ceremony: 4:15 p.m.

Entry Fee: \$22.00 per participant, \$27.00 after February 23<sup>rd</sup>
