THE DETAILS

100% pre-registered, no on-site entries,
entry deadline Nov 25th @ 5:00pm.

Check-in required for all players! All players are required to check in prior to 9:15am. Players who do not check in before 9:15 may be given a 0-point Bye for Round 1. Players ages 12 and older will be required to submit proof of vaccine or negative test at time of check-in.

Scholastic players who also want to play in the WA Class Championships tournament running Fri-Sun at the same site may select the 2-day option or take a bye in round 1 and play rounds 2-6 (since round 1 overlaps with this scholastic tournament).

Health/Safety Protocols: Face masks required for all players and spectators. Please bring your own mask, limited number available. Chess equipment sanitized between rounds. All players and parents (if U18) are required to sign the [WCF Health/Safety Protocols & Waiver of Liability form](#) prior to the start of the tournament.

FORMAT:

A 5-round Swiss
Tournament in 4 sections:

K-3 U800

K-3 Open

4-12 U900

4-12 Open

Play-up into Open sections is allowed.

ELIGIBILITY:

Open to all students
registered in grades K-12.

Grade is based on 2021-2022
school year.

ENTRY FEE:

\$40 if registered by Nov 19,
\$50 after. Room for a
maximum of 124 players.

TIME CONTROL:

Game in 25 minutes with a
5 second delay per move.

This tournament is a **WA State Elementary Qualifier**.

Establish or update your
national rating!

PRIZES:

Trophies for individuals and teams,
medals for upset prizes and first-
time players.

RATING:

US Chess membership required for
the two Open sections (harder) –
these will be dual rated, both
Northwest and US Chess. The U800
and U900 sections (easier) will be
Northwest rated only – US Chess
membership not required for those.

Rd. 5 - 3:15pm

Trophy Presentation about 4:30pm.
