## USCF Section (2-day):

5 round G/90;d10 Swiss in 1 section: **K-8Open 2-day (Barber Qualifier)**.

Rounds: Sat. 9:15am, lunch, 12:45pm, 4:00pm @ Chinook Middle School. Sun. 10:00am, 2:30pm @ Seattle Chess Club. Trophy presentation about 6:00pm. Playoff round(s) if needed to break tie for 1<sup>st</sup> place will be played as one or more G/90 games scheduled at a later date.

Highest finishing WA State resident in the K-8 Open section wins a \$750 travel stipend donated by the WCF and will be the WA State representative at the Barber Tournament of K-8 Champions in Middleton, WI held concurrently with the U.S. Open July 28-31.

Two half-point byes available, must be requested before round 2.  
Entry fees: \$40 before Apr 1st, \$50 after or at paying at the door.

## USCF Sections (1-day April 7th):

4 round G/50;d10 Swiss in 1 section: K-12U1800.

Rounds: Sat. 9:15am, 11:30am, lunch, 2:00pm, 4:00pm.

Entry fees: \$25 before Apr 1st, \$30 after or paying at the door.

## Reserve Sections (1-day April 7th):

5 round G/30 Swiss in 5 sections: K-1U800, 2-3U800, 4-6U1000, K-3U1400, 4-12U1400.

Qualifier for WA State Elementary Tournament.

USCF membership *not* required. NWSRS rated.

Clocks and notation not required. Clocks will be placed after 40 minutes of play with 10 minutes per player, no delay.

Rounds: Sat: 9:15am, 10:30am, lunch, 12:30pm, 1:45pm, 3:00pm. Trophy presentation about 4:15pm

Entry fees: \$25 before Apr 1st, \$30 after or paying at the door.

**All sections:** 100% pre-registered, no on-site entries, entry deadline April 6<sup>th</sup> @ 5:00pm. No registrations accepted after registration deadline. Check-in only required for those that do not pre-pay: 8:00am-8:45am. Players not checked in by 8:45am will receive a zero-point bye for round 1. If you do prepay, show up at 9:00am ready to play round 1 at 9:15am. **Last chance to qualify for the WA State Elementary Chess Championship!**

**All USCF sections:** USCF membership required. Dual rated, both NWSRS and USCF. The NWSRS rating will be used to determine your section, the USCF rating will be used to generate the pairings. Clocks and notation required – bring your own clocks, some clocks will be available to borrow.

**Trophies** for individual, team, plus scores, and upset medals.

Food concessions on site Saturday. Out of state players welcome. Room for 200 players.
