

# Seattle Kings vs. Princes Match III & FIDE Round Robins

## Format:

Kings vs. Princes is a Scheveningen-style match, in which a team of 9 adults (Kings) will play against a team of 9 juniors (Princes). Each player will face one of the opposing team members once over the course of 9 rounds. One or more 10-player FIDE Round Robins (depending on the number of players who accept the invitation) consisting of youth and adult players will be run alongside the Kings vs. Princes Match. All games will be dual USCF and FIDE rated. The aim of these events is to increase the number of Northwest players with established FIDE ratings and to support local junior players seeking experience in preparation for World Youth Competitions.

## Invited Players:

Kings vs. Princes Match: Expert/Master (2000+ USCF)  
FIDE Round Robins: Class A/B (1600-2000 USCF)

**Entry Fee:** \$100

**Time Control:** 90 minutes for the first 40 moves followed by 30 minutes for the rest of the game with an addition of 30 seconds per move starting from move one.

## Prizes:

Individual Prizes: 1<sup>st</sup> \$300, 2<sup>nd</sup> \$250, 3<sup>rd</sup> \$200, 4<sup>th</sup> \$150 awarded to the top scoring players from the Kings team, Princes team, and each FIDE Round Robin.\*

One \$50 best played game prize will be awarded to a King, Prince, or FIDE RR player each round.

*Complimentary ice cream party sponsored by WCF for all participants after the closing ceremony.*

\*Players who withdraw from the tournament will be ineligible to win prizes.
