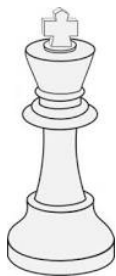
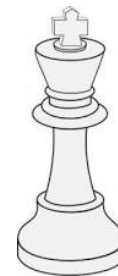

## Mallard Section:

NWSRS and USCF rated. USCF membership required. This section is completely open. 4 rounds of G 45/5. Rounds start at 11:00 AM, 1:00 PM, 3:00 PM, and 5:00 PM.

Prizes:

1<sup>st</sup>: \$100, 2<sup>nd</sup>: \$80, 3<sup>rd</sup>: \$60

## Pekin Section:

NWSRS and USCF rated. USCF membership required. This section is only for players rated below 1600. 4 rounds of G 45/5. Rounds start at 11:00 AM, 1:00 PM, 3:00 PM, and 5:00 PM.

Prizes:

1<sup>st</sup>: \$70, 2<sup>nd</sup>: \$60, 3<sup>rd</sup>: \$50

## Goldeneye Section:

NWSRS rated. This section is open to anyone who does not wish to play in the USCF Section. 4 rounds of G 35/5. Rounds start at 11:10 AM, 12:55 PM, 2:40 PM, and 4:25 PM.

Prizes:

1<sup>st</sup>: \$50, 2<sup>nd</sup>: \$40, 3<sup>rd</sup>: \$30

## Pochard Section:

NWSRS rated. This section is open only to those who are in 5<sup>th</sup> grade or below and are rated under 1000. 5 rounds of G 25/5. Rounds start at 11:10 AM, 12:30 PM, 1:50 PM, 3:10 PM, and 4:30 PM.

Prizes:

1<sup>st</sup>: \$40, 2<sup>nd</sup>: \$30, 3<sup>rd</sup>: \$25

Entry fees: \$25 for the Mallard and Pekin Sections and \$20 for the Goldeneye and Pochard Sections if registered by April 27<sup>th</sup>. Entry fees will increase \$10 if not registered by that date. Entry fees will be paid at the door. Registration, check-in, and entry fee payment from 10 AM-10:45 AM. Clocks and sets will be supplied. Players are encouraged to bring their own clocks if they would like to use them. One half-point bye is allowed if requested prior to round 2. USCF rules apply. Notation and clocks are required in all sections. Prizes based on 40 entrants. If significantly fewer than 40 people enter, the prizes will be scaled down proportional to the number of entrants. The Umpqua and Rogue Rooms will be used as Skittles Rooms. By University of Oregon rule, non-UO students will need to provide their name, address, and social security number to the University in order to collect prize funds. UO students can provide their UO ID instead.
