 Rounds at 9:30am, 10:45am, lunch, 12:45pm, 2:00pm, 3:15pm. Trophy presentation at 4:30pm.
 Generous trophies for individuals, team, plus-scores, and upset awards.
 Scholastic players that also want to play in the WA Class adult tournament running Fri-Sun at the same site may select the 2 day option or take a bye in round 1 and play rounds 2-6 (since round 1 overlaps with Scholastic).
