A 5-round Swiss
Tournament in five sections:

K-1 U800

2-3 U800

K-3 Open

4-8 U900

4-12 Open

*Play-up into Open
sections is allowed.*

ROUNDS:

9:15am, 10:30am,
11:45am, Lunch Break
1:30pm, 2:45pm

TIME CONTROL:

Game in 25 minutes with a 5
second increment per move.

PROCEDURE:

Pairings will be released
prior to the start of each
round. Players will be paired
automatically by the
Tournament Director (TD) in
the Live Chess area.

All players will be monitored
on Zoom while playing.

ENTRY FEE:

\$30 before 10/21,
\$40 after.

Procedure:

Pairings and Standings will be updated on a spreadsheet for every round. Players will be paired automatically by the Tournament Director (TD) in the Live Chess area and will inform the TD of their result upon completion of the game.

Welcome Emails will be sent out to all participants from Tournament Director (see contact information below) shortly before the Tournament

Fair Play Policy:

All players and parents are required to sign the WCF Fair Play Agreement prior to the start of the tournament.

WCF's Fair Play Committee will review any suspicious games on a case-by-case basis. Cheating of any kind is strictly prohibited.
