Qualifications: Open to all WA junior players under age 21 as of Jan 10th, 2020.

Sections:

Closed –

Top 6 juniors in WA State that register for the event will qualify for the closed section, a 5-round G/90; d5 Round Robin.

Entry Fee: \$60

Prizes: - \$125-\$100-\$75 all guaranteed by WCF.

Playoff round to break ties if needed. Playoffs will be conducted Sunday night after the last round.

Winner gets seeded into the WA State Championship in Feb 2020

We will take the top 6 rated players who confirm by the deadline of Jan 5th. All other players will be placed in the invitational section and play alongside the best juniors in WA State in the Closed section.
