## **Washington Girls Championship**

Highest finishing Washington resident in the Championship section receives the title of Washington State Girls Champion and a \$750 travel stipend from the WCF to attend the 2022 <u>Haring National Girls Tournament of Champions</u>, held concurrently with the US Open in early August.

**Format:** A 5-round Swiss in two sections: Championship and Reserve U1400. Maximum of 20 players total & maximum of 12 players in a section - please register early to secure your spot! **WA State Elementary Qualifier**; great training for upcoming State and National events!

- <u>Championship:</u> A 2-day, 5-round G/90; d10 Swiss tournament. Open to all girls desiring to play for the title of WA State Girls Champion. Dual US Chess and NWSRS rated. US Chess membership required. Rounds: Sat. 9am, 1:30pm, 6pm. Sun. 10am, 2:30pm. A tie for first place in the Championship section will be resolved later in the year by two G/90; d10 playoff games.
- Reserve U1400: A 1-day, 5-round, G/25; d5 Swiss tournament. NWSRS rated, US Chess Unrated. US Chess membership <u>not</u> required. Rounds: Sat. 9am, 10:15am, 11:30am, 1:30pm, 2:45pm.

**Eligibility:** Open to all girls registered in grades K-12. Out of state players are welcome! Players must be under the age of 19 as of Sept 1, 2022.

**Rating:** Highest of current NWSRS, or US Chess Regular/Online Feb. supplement rating will be used to determine section, pairings, and prizes.

Byes: Two half-point byes available. If interested, request before the end of round 2.

**Entry fees:** Must be paid by Wed, Feb. 23: **no late or on-site registrations or payments**. Championship: \$50 by Feb. 19, \$60 after. Reserve U1400: \$25 by Feb. 19, \$30 after. Free entry for WGMs, WIMs, WFMs, or US Chess 2000+.

**Registration:** Online registration available at <a href="nwchess.com/OnlineRegistration">nwchess.com/OnlineRegistration</a> Pay by Credit/Debit/PayPal. **Registration, payment, and health/safety form deadline is Wednesday, February 23 by 5:00pm**. No registrations or payments will be accepted after the deadline. Unpaid players will be immediately withdrawn and opened spots will be offered to any players on a Waitlist.

**Prizes:** Amazon Gift Cards prizes awarded in each section (based on 20 total entries). <u>Championship:</u> 1<sup>st</sup> - \$100, 2<sup>nd</sup> - \$80, 3<sup>rd</sup> - \$60, 4<sup>th</sup> - 1-yr WCF ext. <u>Reserve:</u> 1<sup>st</sup> - \$50, 2<sup>nd</sup> - \$40, 3<sup>rd</sup> - \$30, 4<sup>th</sup> - 6-mo WCF ext. <u>Note:</u> Maximum one prize per participant. Medal awarded for best upset per section.

**Health/Safety Protocols:** Face masks required for all players and spectators. Please bring your own mask; a limited number is available. All players and parents (if U18) are required to sign the WCF Health/Safety Protocols & Waiver of Liability form prior to the start of the tournament.
