6-8 Barber

Awards ~ 9pm or asap

Late start available for games that go long. If needed to break ties for 1st place, pairs of G/5; +2 blitz playoff games will be conducted immediately after the last round.

Rating

Dual NWSRS + US Chess rated. Higher of March US Chess or current NWSRS rating used to determine pairings.

Eligibility

Open to the top 12 qualifiers from the Barber + Rockefeller Open Event on March 16. We will take the top 12 qualified players in each section who register and pay by the **deadline of Wed, March 27th**.
