## **Barber Qualifier Section (2-day):**

5 round, dual NWSRS and US Chess-rated, 2-day G/90;d10 Swiss in 1 section: K-8Open (Barber Qualifier). Rounds: Sat. 9:15am, 12:45pm @ Chinook Middle School. Sun. 9:30am, 1:00pm, 4:30pm @ PNW Chess Center. Playoff round(s) if needed to break tie for 1st place will be played as one or more G/90 games scheduled at a later date. (Playoff must be held within 6 weeks of completion of event)

Highest finishing WA State resident in the K-8 Open section wins a \$750 travel stipend donated by the WCF and will be the WA State representative at the Barber Tournament of K-8 Champions in Orlando, FL held concurrently with the U.S. Open Aug 3-6.

Two half-point byes available, must be requested before round 2. Entry fees: \$50 before Mar 16<sup>th</sup>, \$60 after or at paying at the door.

Entry fees: \$30 before Mar 23<sup>rd</sup>, \$40 after or paying at the door.  
US Chess Membership *is* required for these sections. NWSRS ratings will be used for pairings.

### **NWSRS Sections: K-1 U800, 2-3 U800, 4-8 U900**

5 round G/25;d5 Swiss in 3 sections: K-1 U800, 2-3 U800, 4-8 U900  
Rounds: Sat. 9:15am, 10:30am, 12:00pm, 1:15pm, 2:30pm, Trophy Presentation around 4:00pm  
Entry fees: \$30 before Mar 23<sup>rd</sup>, \$40 after or paying at the door.  
US Chess Membership *not* required for these sections. NWSRS ratings will be used for pairings,

**All sections:** Entry deadline March 29<sup>th</sup> @ 5:00pm. Check-in only required for those that do not pre-pay: 8:00am-8:45am. Players not checked in by 8:45am will receive a zero-point bye for round 1. If you do prepay, show up at 9:00am ready to play round 1 at 9:15am.  
Trophies for individual, team, plus, upset medals, and first-timer medals  
Food concessions on site Saturday. Out of state players welcome. Room for 200 players.  
This tournament is a State Championship Qualifier
