NWSRS Rated. Event will be US  
Chess rated if held in person.  
US Chess & WCF membership  
required.

## ELIGIBILITY:

Each Section consists of 6 players:

1 Qualifier from Open Event  
(4/10)

4 highest rated (USCF or NWSRS  
rating)

1 Wild Card (TD Pick)

Participants will be finalized on  
5/26 and Lots will be drawn for  
colors.

Director (TD) in the Live Chess area and will  
inform the TD of their result upon  
completion of the game.
