## **Barber/Rockefeller Qualifier Section (2-day):**

A 5-round, 2-day G/90+30 inc. Swiss in 2 section: K-5 Open (Rockefeller Qualifier) and 6-8 Open (Barber Qualifier), strict grade enforcement required.

**Rounds:** Sat. 9:15am, 1:30pm, 5:45pm. Sun. 9:15am, 1:30pm. Playoff round(s) if needed to break tie for 1<sup>st</sup> place will be played as one or more G/90+30 inc. games scheduled at a future date.

*Highest finishing WA State resident in both the K-5 Open section and the 6-8 Open Section will win a \$750 travel stipend (donated by the WCF) and will be the WA State representatives at the Rockefeller (K-5) and Barber (6-8) Tournament of Champions in St. Louis, MO held concurrently with the U.S. Open Aug 8-11, 2020.*

**Entry fee:** \$50 before Fri. Apr 3, \$60 after.

**Byes:** Two half-point byes available, must be requested before round 3.

## **K-8 Scholastic Sections (1-day):**

A 5-round G/25+5 inc. Swiss in 5 sections: K-1 U800, 2-3 U800, 4-8 U900, K-3 Open, 4-8 Open.

**Rounds:** Sat. 9:15am, 10:25am, 11:35am, 12:45pm, 1:55pm.

**Entry fee:** \$35 before Fri. Apr 3, \$45 after.

## **All Sections:**

**All games will be played online via chess.com due to the global COVID-19 Coronavirus situation.**

All players must have a Chess.com account and join the [WCF Club](#). Registration deadline Fri. Apr 10 @ 5:00pm. No registrations or payments will be accepted after deadline. No check-in since this is an online tournament. Unpaid players will be withdrawn from the tournament prior to the start of round 1. Trophies/medals will be available for pick-up after the tournament, awarded to the top-scoring individuals and medals for first timers that don't earn a trophy. All sections will be determined and paired by Northwest ratings. US Chess membership not required.

**Fair Play Policy:** All players and parents will be required to sign the [WCF Fair Play Agreement](#) prior to the start of the tournament. WCF's fair play committee will review any suspicious games on a case by case basis. Cheating of any kind is strictly prohibited.

This tournament is a WA State Elementary Qualifier.
