Details

Purpose: The prize fund will be equal to approximately 25% of entry fees, with the remainder being distributed equally between Chess for Success and the Black United Fund of Oregon.

Date and Time: Saturday June 27, 2020, 10:00am - 4:00pm

Format: 5-round Swiss Paired, G/25d5 (25 minutes per player, with 5 second delay on each move). Participants will compete in the section that corresponds to their highest rating in Lichess, USCF, or NWSRS. The passwords for each section (U1000, U1400, U1800, and Open) will be emailed one day before the tournament.

Prizes: 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winners in each section will receive \$30, \$20, and \$10 respectively. Cash prizes based on 100 participants. Prize fund will be modified at the discretion of the organizers if participation is lower.

Cost: \$10.00 per player

Registration Deadline: 8:00pm on Friday, June 26th (no same day registration)
