

	The PNWCC Friday Night Rapid tournament features Fischer Random Chess, G15 PRO Rapid and two-game G45 match between closely rated players.

G45 Duel	
<b>Description</b>	USCF and NWSRS Dual Rated 2-round match between two closely rated players. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Higher of NWSRS and USCF rating will be used to decide match opponents</li> <li>Players will be group into pairs of two most closely rated players to play a match of two games. No.1 rated player will play No.2 rated player for two G45 games, No.3 rated player will play No.4 rated player etc.</li> <li>Higher rated player will play White in round 1. Switch color in round 2</li> <li>Match will be NWSRS and USCF dual rated.</li> <li>If this section has odd number of players, the <b>lowest rated 3 players</b> will play a round-robin G30;d5 mini-tournament.</li> </ul>
<b>Schedule</b>	Round 1 - 7:00PM Round 2 - 8:30PM <b>or as soon as round 1 finish</b> . Each match can start independently in round 2.
<b>Time Control</b>	G45 with 5 seconds delay

<b>Rating</b>	USCF and NWSRS dual rated
<b>Membership</b>	USCF membership required – purchase <a href="#">here</a>
<b>Entry Fee</b>	\$20 before Friday and \$25 on Friday
<b>Trophy</b>	Winner of the match will get a PNWCC G45 Duel Trophy. Tied match will play unrated blitz to decide trophy winner.
<b>Byes</b>	No bye allowed.
<b>Cancelation Policy</b>	If we have only one player signs up, we will cancel the G45 Duel.

<b>G15 Pro</b>	
<b>Description</b>	USCF Quick Rated 4-round rapid tournament with time control G/15;+2.
<b>Schedule</b>	7:00PM-7:45PM-8:30PM-9:15PM
<b>Time Control</b>	15 minutes with a 2 second increment, same as PRO Chess League
<b>Rating</b>	USCF Quick rated. No minimum rating requirement. USCF regular rating will be used for pairing.
<b>Membership</b>	USCF membership required – purchase <a href="#">here</a>
<b>Entry Fee</b>	USCF 2200+ play for free \$20 before Friday and \$25 on Friday.
<b>Prize</b>	1 <sup>st</sup> place 25% of paid entries 2 <sup>nd</sup> place 15% of paid entries 3 <sup>rd</sup> place 10% of paid entries
<b>Byes</b>	1 half-point byes available. Request on registration or before round 2 starts

<b>Fischer Random Chess (Chess960)</b>	
<b>Description</b>	Un-rated 3-round double-swiss (6 games, 2 games with same opponent switching color with same starting positions) rapid tournament of Chess 960 with time control G/10;+2. Starting position will be announced before each round by tournament director – <a href="http://www.chessgames.com/perl/fischerandom">http://www.chessgames.com/perl/fischerandom</a> 5 minutes time will be given for preparation.
<b>Schedule</b>	7:00PM-8:00PM-9:00PM
<b>Time Control</b>	10 minutes with a 2 second increment
<b>Rating</b>	Unrated USCF Rating will be used for pairing.
<b>Membership</b>	USCF membership required – purchase <a href="#">here</a>
<b>Entry Fee</b>	USCF 2200+ play for free \$20 before Friday and \$25 on Friday.
<b>Prize</b>	1 <sup>st</sup> place 25% of paid entries 2 <sup>nd</sup> place 15% of paid entries 3 <sup>rd</sup> place 10% of paid entries
<b>Byes</b>	1 half-point byes available. Request on registration or before round 2 starts
