Format: Three Scheveningen-style matches, in which teams of 5 adults (Kings/Queens) will play against teams of 5 juniors (Princes/Princesses). Each player will face each of the opposing team members once over the course of 5 rounds. All games will be tri-rated: NWSRS, US Chess, and FIDE. The aim of these events is to support local junior players seeking experience in preparation for National and International competitions.

Sections: Highest of current NWSRS, US Chess, or FIDE rating will be used to determine pairings and section.

Kings vs Princes A (2000+)

Kings vs Princes B (1800+)

Kings vs Princes C (1600+)

Entry Fee: \$150. Free entry for GMs, IMs, FMs, WGMs, WIMs, WFM, and 2400+ USCF.

Time Control: G/90+30.

Byes: There will be no byes allowed in any of the sections since this is a prestigious Scheveningen Match. Players who withdraw from the match will be ineligible to play in future WCF invitational events for up to 1 year.

Schedule: Drawing of lots: The drawing of lots will take place on Sunday 7/24 @ 10pm via Zoom. Attendance is optional, though encouraged.

Rounds: Fri, 7/29 - Check-in: 6:00-6:45pm, Rd 1: 7pm

Sat, 7/30 - Rd 2: 10am, Rd 3: 3pm.

Sun, 7/31 - Rd 4: 10am, Rd 5: 3pm, Closing Ceremony: ~7pm or ASAP.

Prizes: Winning team: 1st \$400, 2nd \$300, 3rd \$200.

Losing team: 1st \$200, 2nd \$150, 3rd \$100.

*Players who withdraw from the match will be ineligible to win prize money.

Registration: Please register online at nwchess.com/OnlineRegistration/. We will take the top 5 rated players in each section who confirm by the deadline of July 23rd at 5pm.
