Format: A four-round Swiss system tournament in four sections. USCF RATED. USCF membership required. Limited to 52 players. OCF, WCF, ICA memberships encouraged.

Sections: The event intends 10, 14, 14, and 14 players in respective sections arranged primarily by rating. Each section, each game will be competitive, the way you like it. The time control is a commonly used FIDE, and now a USCF, standard appropriate for the event. You must record each move in your game, move by move. Please bring your chess set and digital chess clock.

Open: rating over 2000. Premier: rating between 1700 and 2000. Reserve: rating between 1400 and 1700. Booster: rating under 1400, or unrated.

Time control: Game in 90 minutes, with 30 seconds increment each move throughout game.

Byes: Half-point bye available only at registration for any round except Round 4.

Entry Fee: if mailed by May 31 Open: \$60, Premier: \$50, Reserve: \$40, Booster: \$30

To play up one section add \$20 to your regular section fee. Add \$10 to total after early deadline. *No in-person registration planned.* Purchase all chess memberships in advance, on-line. With so many options for you to decide among, do this in the comfort of your home.

Prize Fund: Based on 52 players. 80% of each prize is guaranteed. A 2015 Northwest Grand Prix event.
