

# Oregon Class Championships: November 3-4

Four-round Swiss in five sections, **Master/Expert** (2000+), **Class A** (1800-1999), **Class B** (1600-1799), **Class C** (1400-1599), and **Class D and below** (under 1400); Players may play up only one **class**; 40/90,SD/30;inc30; one half-point bye is available if requested before round one; US Chess rated. **Due to space at the club facility, the tournament is limited to the first fifty players who register. Please pre-register.** To do so, we must **receive** your registration information at [nwchess.com/onlineregistration](http://nwchess.com/onlineregistration) **and** your entry fee and any membership fees either online or through the mail by Thursday, November 1. If you don't pre-register and there are still spots open, on-site registration is available from 9-9:45am Saturday. The rounds are scheduled for 10am and 3:45pm each day.

## Prize Fund: \$2000 based on 50 entries

Each section has the following overall prizes: 1st-\$200, 2nd-\$100, 3rd-\$70. The Master/Expert section also has a \$75 U2200 prize and the Class D and below section also has a \$75 U1200 prize. Unrated players are eligible for all the prizes. Bonus prizes: Any player who goes 4-0 wins free entry into next year's Oregon Class Championships. Any scholastic player who scores at least 2.5 will be able to select a trophy.

**Entry Fee:** \$50 (and add \$10 if you are playing up a class) if you pre-register by Thursday, November 1. If there are still spots open and you register on-site, the entry fee is \$65 (and add \$10 if you are playing up a class; only cash or check accepted on-site). US Chess and OCF/WCF/ICA memberships are also required.

**Other: Bring a digital clock;** Northwest Chess Grand Prix event; qualifier for the Oregon State Championship, Oregon Invitational Tournament, and OSCF State Championship; see more information at [pdxchess.org](http://pdxchess.org)
