If a player withdraws after 48 hours prior to the first round, no refund will be given.</li> </ul>

<b>Rounds</b>	5 rounds (All round times are in PST) Saturday: 11:00, Lunch break, 2:30, 5:00. Sunday: 11:00, Lunch break, 2:30, Awards Ceremony at 5:00
<b>Fair-Play Policy</b>	All Participants must be on a live zoom call with the host. During your round, you must be sharing screens on the zoom call. Players may take a maximum of 3-bathroom breaks during their round, and each break may not be more than 5-10 minutes. Players also, may only use the bathroom on their opponents turn. If for some reason, a player has to use the bathroom more than 3 times, and for longer durations, the player's parent or guardian (if the player is below the age of 18) must inform the host on the reason (medical, stomachache etc.) If a player wants to get up from the board to stretch, they must always have the screen facing them, so they can be monitored. Cheating or violation of any of these rules will not be tolerated and will result in a forfeit of the game and the tournament with no refund. <b>The link to sign the Fair play agreement is below: Please sign this agreement no later than July 15<sup>th</sup>.</b>

<b>Chess.com</b>	The site for this tournament will be on Chess.com due to the Covid-19 situation. Players must be on the zoom call 15 minutes prior to the start of the round for, announcements. When the round starts, players will be asked to challenge their opponent on the chess.com site with the proper time control. <b>Make sure you are familiar with chess.com and have a chess.com account. I do not want to have to manage starting 20 games at once because players do not know how to use the website.</b>
<b>½ point bye</b>	Players must announce all half point byes during the registration process. A maximum of two half point byes are allowed for all sections and players.
<b>Prizes</b>	Prize Fund (based on 50 entries): Championship: 1st = \$375 2nd = \$250 3rd = \$175 Prodigies: 1 <sup>st</sup> = \$200 2nd = \$125 3rd = \$75 Top U1550 = \$100. Rising Stars: 1st = \$125 2nd = \$75 Top U950 = \$75
<b>Rating</b>	This tournament will be unrated. USCF Ratings will be used for the pairings.
