Unpaid players not checked in by 8:45am will receive a zero-point bye for round 1. This event is a qualifier for the WA State Elementary Tournament in April. Players scoring 2.5+ points in the 4-round sections or 3.0+ points in the 5-round sections will qualify for State.

A 5-round G/30 Swiss in 3 sections: K-1U800, 2-3U800, & 4-6U900.

For novice to intermediate players. US Chess membership *not* required, Northwest rated only. Rounds: 9:15am, 10:45am, lunch, 12:45pm, 2:15pm, 3:45pm. Trophy presentation at 5:15pm.

Dual Rated Sections:

Longer time controls for intermediate and advanced players. Update or establish your national rating! Dual rated, both Northwest and US Chess. US Chess membership required. The Northwest rating will be used to determine section and generate the pairings. Clocks and notation required – limited number of clocks available to borrow. Scoresheets and pencils provided.

A 4-round G/50; d5 Swiss in two sections: Open & U1600.

For intermediate to advanced players or anyone looking for a challenge.

Rounds: 9:15am, 11:15am, lunch, 1:45pm, 3:45pm. Trophy presentation at 5:45pm.

Playoff rounds if needed to break ties for 1st place at 5:45pm: G/10 white, G/8 black with draw odds. Highest finishing WA resident in the Open section seeds into the *Premier section of the WA State Championship in Feb 2019*, and the *2020 WA Junior Closed*.
