USCF Sections – a 4 round G/50 Swiss in 2 sections: Open and U1600.

Longer time controls for advanced players.

Open to all juniors under 21 as of tournament date.

WA winner of the Open section seeds into the WA Premier section in Feb 2017, and the WA Junior Closed tournament next year.

USCF membership required. Update or establish your national rating!

Dual rated, both NWSRS and USCF. The NWSRS rating is used to determine which section you may enter, and the USCF rating is used to generate the pairings.

Qualifier for WA State Elementary Tournament (you still need 3.0 points to qualify).

Clocks and notation required – some clocks available to borrow.

Rounds: 9:15am, 11:15am, lunch, 1:45pm, 3:45pm. Trophy presentation at 5:45pm.

Playoff rounds if needed to break ties for 1st place at 5:45pm: G/10 white, G/8 black with draw odds.

Reserve sections: 5 round G/30 Swiss in 5 sections: K-1U800, 2-3U800, K-3U1400, 4-6U900, 4-12U1400.

For intermediate and beginning players.

Qualifier for WA State Elementary Tournament.

USCF membership *not* required. NWSRS rated.

Rounds: 9:15am, 10:30am, lunch, 12:30pm, 1:45pm, 3:00pm. Trophy presentation at 4:15pm

All sections: 100% pre-registered, no on-site entries, entry deadline Jan 15th @ 5:00pm. No registrations accepted after registration deadline. Check-in required **only for those that did not pre-pay:** 8:00am-8:45am. Unpaid players not checked in by 8:45am will receive a zero-point bye for round 1.

Entry Fees:

Early Entry Fee (deadline Jan 9th) \$20.00

Late Entry Fee (Jan 10th or later) \$25.00

Trophies for individual, team, plus scores, and upset medals.

Out of state players welcome.

Room for 300 players. We had 257 last year.
