Foreign ratings used for players with no USCF rating.

Time Controls: Open 40/2, SD/1; Reserve Sat. 40/90, SD/30, Sun. 40/2, SD/1.

Registration: Saturday 8:00-9:00 AM.

Rounds: Open Sat. 10:00, 5:00, Sun. 9:00, 3:30.

Reserve Sat. 10:00, 2:30, 7:00, Sun. 9:00, 3:30.

Entry Fee: \$35 postmarked or online by 10/24, \$45 after 10/24 or at site.

Make checks payable to Washington Chess Federation. Free entry for GMs, IMs, WGMs.

Prize fund: \$800 (based on 40 paid entries).

Reserve 1<sup>st</sup> \$120, 2<sup>nd</sup> \$100, 1<sup>st</sup> U1600 \$60, 1<sup>st</sup> U1400 \$60, 1<sup>st</sup> U1200 \$60

Byes: One half-point bye available (Reserve section), request by end of round 2.
