#### About future rated tournaments:

The club will sponsor U. S. Chess rated tournaments regularly, both in the club, and occasional weekend events (usually one day on a Saturday). We will have such events going forward, including a Saturday event scheduled for the third Saturday of May, and likely rated tournaments in the club in months that do not have a weekend event. Rated events do require current U.S. Chess memberships for

all players (may be purchased at registration). They also require adherence to the more formal tournament rules (use chess clocks, touch move, keeping score, etc.). If you need to review those, drop by the club. We will also answer rules questions during the announcements at the tournament before the start of the first round.

In most tournaments, all players play all rounds. No one is eliminated by a loss. <u>But if you find you must miss a round or leave the event early, be sure to tell the tournament director</u>. For multi week tournaments at the club, call or email a message to the tournament director if you find you are sick or have an unexpected conflict. That way you won't be paired, so no player will have to win by forfeit, and thus not get an official rated game.

The club could use someone else to become a certified tournament director, first as another backup, and later perhaps as a head director. Please contact the club director if you are interested.

#### About future chess classes:

We are working on a new plan for chess instruction connected to the club. Topics could include in depth topics like middle game themes, types of chess openings, types of chess endgames, contributions to chess theory of the older chess masters, and chess traps, pitfalls and swindles (how to spot and avoid such). Suggestions about how to best provide for such instruction would be welcome! Club members who would like to teach newer players should mention that to the club director, as we get frequent requests for such instruction.

#### Rated Blitz Tournament:

On May 25, we will hold a blitz tournament, rated by U.S. Chess. They have separate ratings for events with time controls of less than game in 10 minutes. Since this will be rated, U. S. Chess membership is required. The event will have about 8-10 games, depending on number of entries. Register 6 to 6:30 p.m. Entry fee \$5. Pairing system (single round robin, double round robin, or Swiss) will depend on the number of entries. Time control is Game in 5 minutes, delay 3 seconds. Prizes per entries.

#### Election of Club Officers

There will be an election of new club officers at 6:30 p.m., before the Blitz tournament at our meeting on May 25. We need to elect a President, a Vice-President, and a Secretary-Treasurer. Please try to arrive early that night, so as not to delay the start of the Blitz Tournament.
